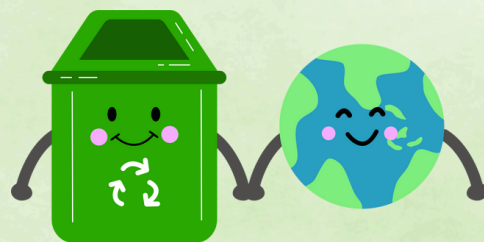

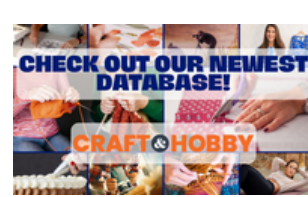

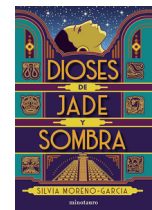


Enero 24 Huesos olvidados de Preston & Child
